MAXIMIZING IMPACT

- Work Programme and calls
 - **expected outcomes specified in the topics** (+ their link to the wider targeted impacts)
 - topics will be open to a range a different pathways to achieve those impacts
- Proposal submission and evaluation
 - new modalities to maximise impact of **portfolio-based calls** (missions)
- Dissemination and Exploitation
 - support beneficiaries in D&E results (**Horizon Results Platform → structured questionnaire, Results ownership list, Horizon Impact Awards, D&E boosters**)

MAIN ORIENTATION OF THE STRATEGY

GREATER TRANSPARENCY
AND FURTHER SIMPLIFICATION

- Work Programme and calls
 - simpler, less complex Work Programme
- Proposal submission and evaluation
 - Proposal: less information (**page limit cut**), reference to external sources (**researchers ID**)
 - „**blind evaluation**“ (anonymised first stage proposal), „**right to react**“ (rebutal) pilot
- Simplification via **corporate MGA**
 - Quick-glance data sheet
 - Single formula for calculation personnel costs
 - Online annotated model grant agreement (**e-AGA**)
 - Using **lump sums**
- Control strategy
 - **System and Process Audits** (SPAs), **cross-reliance** on audits


